Eliminated Child Marriage- the biggest challenge- as the initial plan

Covered 8307 young women in 174 villages of District Udaipur, Rajasthan

Created teams of "Manzil Sakhi" in high-focused villages across 6 clusters in Udaipur

The project is also creating multiple category of social media groups, undertaking daily review of vaccination of girls and women, doing an on-line virtual interaction and training of girls, building awareness on use of digital technology for vocational education and employability.

Despite challenges posed by Covid-19, our warriors didn't skip on the opportunity to help! The team continues to encourage young girls to get vaccinated and keep making progress in their lives!

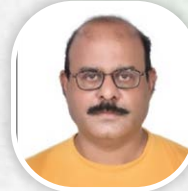

As a core member of Women in Economics/ Policy, worked on creating Covid-19 relief resources like hospitals, ICU beds, Food and Oxygen Cylinders for New Delhi and NCR and built information resources on vaccination, importance of masks and home treatments of Coronavirus.

Extended support to an NGO in Andhra Pradesh, called **HELP**; created a citizen fund-sourcing campaign with an NGO called **Lightup** on ketto.org platform, for marginalized children in Delhi from the GB road area to provide ration, sanitary hygiene products, books and medicines.

The club also provided sanitizers, masks, school bags, tiffin and water bottles to the needy and poor families.

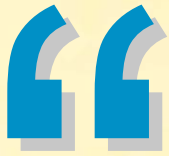

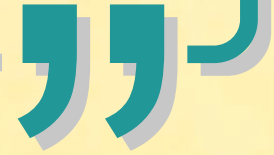

In the labor camp of the Sewerage project at Bhilwara, a woman labourer who was pregnant had delivery/labor pains in middle of the night and her position was critical. Luckily, the fellow labourers had the mobile numbers of a female Social Outreach Team (SOT) member working under the Social Expert of CAPC town unit. On receiving emergency call at midnight the Social Expert and female SOT member rushed to the spot and despite a strict lock down without any delay arranged for the ambulance and took her to the hospital. Since, it was pre-mature delivery case, the conditions were very critical... and despite all efforts the child could not be saved. But quick response of the female SOT member and Social Expert saved the women's life who is now out of danger. Even post hospitalization, the Town Expert arranged for all possible facilities and help like food, medicines etc.,

We hope such humane acts never cease to exist, no matter by whom!

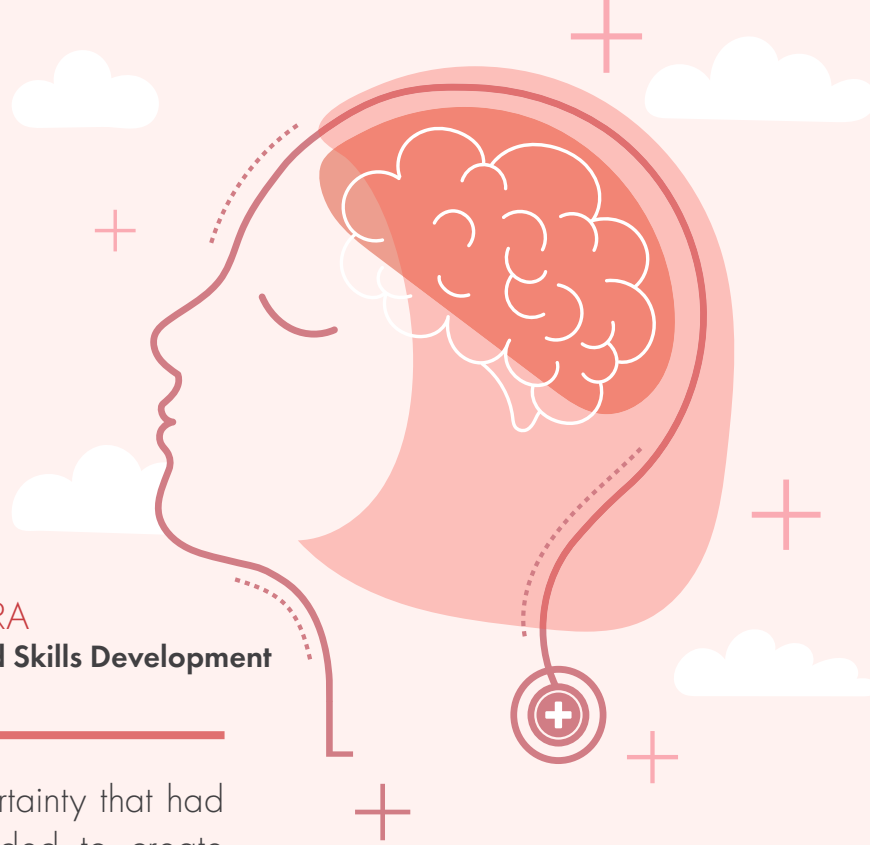
